The History of Quincy Notre Dame High School

The philosophy of Quincy Notre Dame High School permeates the spiritual, social, academic, and extracurricular areas of the school.

Quincy Notre Dame, as a private Catholic co-educational high school, seeks to build a community of learners among its faculty, staff, students, and parents. Founded on faith in God and trust among its members, this community strives to make Catholic values an integral part of its existence. Quincy Notre Dame fosters an environment of consideration and acceptance, while challenging its members to develop their potential through strong educational and extracurricular programs. Quincy Notre Dame strives to prepare its students to assume vital Christian roles in a constantly changing world.

Quincy Notre Dame traces its roots back to 1859 when Bishop Junker of Alton invited the Schools Sisters of Notre Dame to Quincy when 200 children were in one classroom at St. Boniface School. From 1861 to 1873, the School Sisters of Notre Dame started the St. Lawrence School - now St. Peter - and they opened the Convent of Infant Jesus at 8th and Vermont. In 1873 the school was chartered by the state and called St. Mary Institute. In 1894 St. Mary Institute was chartered as a four year high school and became fully accredited as St. Mary Academy in 1910.

In 1928 the name was officially changed to Notre Dame of Quincy. In 1940 Quincy College Academy for Boys closed and the boys came to Notre Dame for what was to be a “temporary stay.” The boys stayed for nineteen years, which required complete remodeling for the influx of male students. In 1957 Notre Dame’s enrollment had increased to three times what it was twenty years before, and plans for a new boys’ high school were adopted. In 1959 Notre Dame again became an all girls’ school and a new boys’ school was opened at 10th and Jackson Street staffed by the Christian Brothers Religious Order. The boys’ school at that time was called Christian Brothers High School.

In 1969 the Christian Brothers no longer had sufficient personnel available to staff Christian Brothers High School. In the next year two Servite fathers and Servite brothers agreed to administer and teach at the boys’ high school. A new Quincy corporation was formed and the boys’ school was converted

to a locally owned private institution controlled by a Board of Directors which was made up of local business men and women of all faiths. The school was then chartered as Catholic Boys' High School.

In 1975 an effort was made to provide a broader, more expansive educational program. Notre Dame and Catholic Boys' High School agreed to consolidate. Once again Quincy and the surrounding communities became instrumental in helping the newly consolidated school by pledging \$500,000 over a three year period to supplement operating costs and to provide some capital improvements. In 1976 the school became Quincy Notre Dame High School and is still operating under this same name today at 10th and Jackson.

Thanks to the Quincy Notre Dame Development Program, committed Board members, supportive parents, and great teachers and students, Quincy Notre Dame has flourished since that time. In the past ten years Quincy Notre Dame has seen an increase of over 50% in enrollment. Alumni now visit Quincy Notre Dame and find a renovated facility surrounded by outstanding athletic fields.

Each year over 85% of the graduates of Quincy Notre Dame go on to college. The number of National Merit Finalists, Semi-Finalists, Commended Students, as well as Illinois State Scholars is outstanding. Quincy Notre Dame also is one of the most honored schools in the country by West Point Academy. At the present time fifteen QND graduates have attended West Point Academy.

For over a century Quincy Notre Dame High School has provided quality, Catholic education for Quincy and the surrounding areas. QND will continue to be "The Place To Be" because of the commitment of staff, students, parents, and supporters of the school.
