Parents:

Monday, Tuesday and Thursday of each week, for 1 to 1.5 hours after school, one or two teachers will supervise students who wish to take advantage of this program. Students are welcome to attend as often as needed. We would also like for parents to work in cooperation with teachers to direct students who are at risk of being unsuccessful. Students will sign in and out and a record of their attendance and activity will be logged. A parent may contact Mrs. Kasparie at any time to check their student's attendance.

This year, teachers may recommend that your student attend Classroom Connection on a temporary basis:

- To catch up on missed work due to absence
- To prepare for assessments
- To complete work that is incomplete or missing
- To get assistance on a particular lesson

In such cases, Mrs. Kasparie will contact the student and the parent to inform them that a request has been made by a teacher.
